

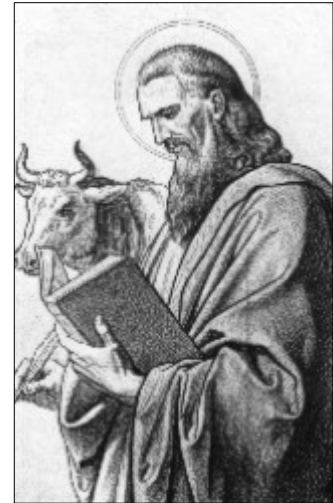

About Luke...

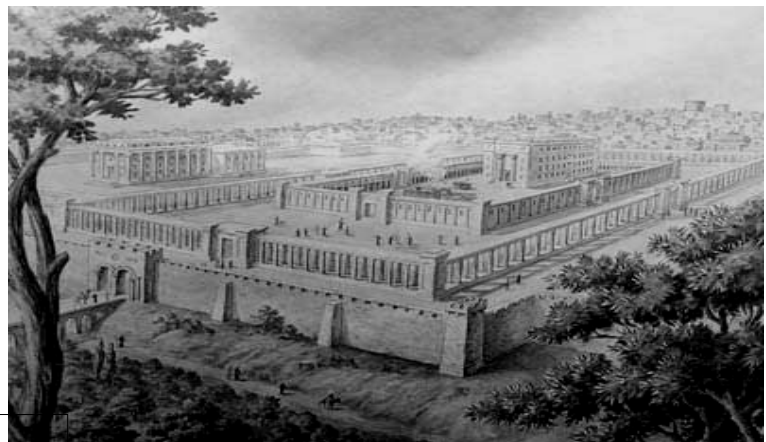
- Author of the 3rd Gospel
 - A companion and fellow worker of Paul
 - o Beloved physician
 - o Gospel writer for the Gentile Community
- Written between 63-70 A.D/ CE (“Common Era”)
- Luke’s principle source was Mark
 - The Gospel begins and ends in Jerusalem in the Temple



Prologue Luke 1:1 – 4

Action 1

- An orderly account
 - Eyewitnesses (respect)
 - Careful, investigative
- Know the Truth



Action 2

- Zechariah – priestly order
- Wife Elizabeth
- Descendant of Aaron
- Righteous couple—No children – punishment

II a – Incense

- Sanctuary of the Lord – Holy of Holies
- To offer incense – to give praise to God

II b

- An angel appeared
 - Fearful – Do not be afraid
 - Your wife will bear a son – call him John
 - Great Joy
 - He will do great things
 - Zechariah did not listen – as a result
- Verses 19-20



Action 3

Incense
To Praise God
Holy of Holies
Praise of God

Action 4

- An angel appeared to Zechariah – he was fearful
 - Question God – call son
 - John – Joy – He will do great things
 - Zechariah did not listen
- Luke 1:18-20

Action 5

- Luke 1:21-23
- Zechariah could not speak

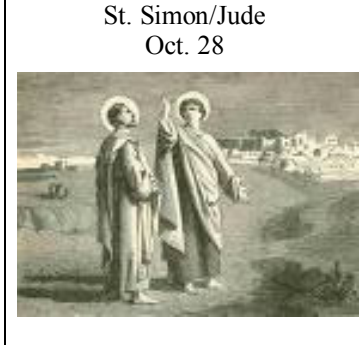

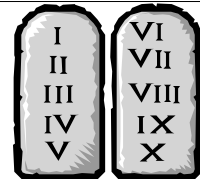
