At the gate of his house there was a poor man who begged for food. His name was Lazarus.

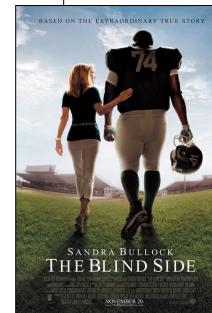
Lazarus satisfied his hunger by eating the crumbs that fell from the table. Lazarus died and went to heaven surrounded by angels.

The Question is: "Where is *your* Heart in every day life?"

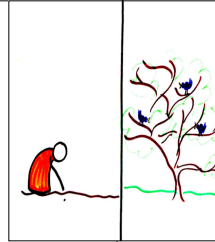


CHAPTER 17:5-6
